In remembrance of the 100th Anniversary of WWI, Aaron Copland's poignant *Quiet City* will accompany a photo montage of "The Great War." WWII images commemorating the 75th anniversary of mankind's most widespread conflict will be underscored by the third movement of Vaughan Williams' *Symphony No. 5*. The program also includes Veteran Samuel Barber's *Essay No. 2*, excerpts from Richard Rodgers stirring *Victory at Sea*, and Copland's inspirational, *Lincoln Portrait*.
